

God said in Revelation 3:20 of the Bible,  
"Listen! I am standing at the door, knocking; if you hear my  
voice and open the door, I will come in to you and eat with you,  
and you with me."

It's that simple, and that profound!

If interested, **here is how you can:**

**1. Admit your need.** (Admit, "I am a sinner so I keep stumbling and tripping up in life. I truly feel little or no peace, and not much real joy. Sometimes I hurt or use others through my actions and words. Often, I dishonor God who made me.")

**2. Be willing to turn from your sins.** (Repent. "I am tired of stumbling through life and not feeling at peace. I am sorry to God, to myself, and to others for my sins and I really want to live a better, more meaningful life.")

**3. Believe that God can and will forgive you of all your sins. He does this as Jesus Christ, God the Son, died on the Cross and rose from the grave, for you.** ("God, I accept your forgiveness and I look forward to living as your cleaned up child, both in my life now, and then forever in Heaven with you.")

**4. In prayer, invite God, through the Holy Spirit, to now be your life's Guide.** ("God, I love you for all that you give to me. In thanks to You, I want to live out your purposes for my life. I want to honor You.")

**How to pray to God, to receive Him:**

Dear God, I admit that I sin. I thank you for sending Your son Jesus to die on the cross for my sin, for forgiving me. I now invite you to come into my life and make me who you want me to be. Amen.

If you sincerely went through steps 1—4 above, you have just made a wonderful decision for your life. And, it's just the beginning of a life-long relationship. To grow in your relationship with God:

1) Read the Bible (God's Word) often to learn more about God and His plan for your life. (*Probably start with the book of John --- 4<sup>th</sup> book in the New Testament of the Bible.*)

2) Pray to God often, sharing your joys and burdens.

3) Go to a church where you can receive support in growing in God.

4) Share your faith. You've received a wonderful gift. Tell others about it!
